<p>Supposedly defeats death on the third day after preparation/fasting (Esther 4:16)</p>	<p>Defeats death by rising on the third day after crucifixion and burial (Mathew 28:1-6; 1 Corinthians 15:4)</p>	<p>Zionism “rises” through political maneuvering; true victory through death-defeating resurrection.</p>
<p>Three days of fasting and putting on royal apparel for calculated seduction and access</p>	<p>Real suffering, death, and burial. No self-adornment. Full obedience to the Father’s will.</p>	<p>Zionism relies on external beauty and strategy. True rise flows from internal sacrifice and resurrection power.</p>
<p>Boldy stands in the inner court of earthly king (Ahasuerus = State power); risks but expects favor.</p>	<p>Ascends to the right hand of the Father in heaven (Hebrews 1:3; Acts 2:32-33)</p>	<p>False queen approaches pagan State for favor. True King returns to divine authority.</p>
<p>Adorns herself in luxurious royal apparel to captivate</p>	<p>Appears in glorified resurrection body; shows wounds as proof of victory</p>	<p>Seductive pageantry vs. authentic glory. Replacement system wears the outward trappings of legitimacy.</p>
